NATIONAL ADAPTATION PLAN (NAP) APPROACH: Viet Nam's National Adaptation Plan will be for the period 2021-2030, Vision 2050

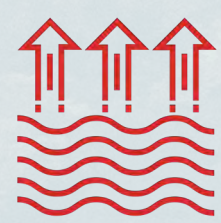
Viet Nam's National Adaptation Plan process is ongoing. Adaptation plays a key role in Viet Nam's Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC), which is being reviewed and updated by the Ministry of Natural Resources and the Environment through an interministerial working group and stakeholder consultations. The objectives of the National Climate Change Adaptation Plan are to: (i) Reduce vulnerabilities to climate change impacts, by enhancing adaptive capacity and resilience; (ii) Enhance the integration of climate change adaptation actions into relevant policies, strategies, programs and projects, especially in socio-economic development planning of ministries, branches and localities.

Viet Nam's revised NDC is expected to be completed and submitted by the end of 2020.

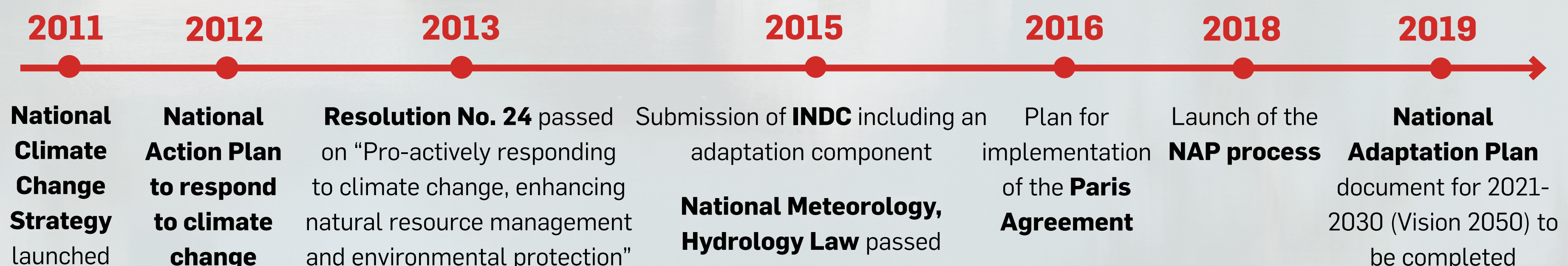
